

PURSE INSTRUCTIONS

Supplies:

Crazy quilted piece measuring 8" X 17" (for purse outside)

Lining for purse measuring 8" X 17"

7" Fancy fringe for purse flap (my fringe is 3" wide)

1 Yard decorative cord for purse handle.

Turn under edges of Image and machine or hand sew in place on purse flap. See picture. Pin fringe to right side of crazy quilted piece across the end that will be the flap of the purse.

My purse handle measures 30". Determine how long you wish yours to be. Pin the cord in place, 5 1/4" from the fringed sewing line on each side.

Pin lining to crazy quilt, right sides together, including the fringe edge and the cord ends. You can pin the fringe and excess cord out of the way of the sewing.

Leave a 1/4" seam allowance. Sew around three sides of the purse, leaving the small end (without the fringe) open. Sew across the cord ends twice. Turn purse to the right side and press. Turn under raw edges of lining and crazy quilt at the open end and press. This will be sewn shut with the blanket stitch when sewing the purse together. Fold un-sewn end of purse up to just below the cord attachment. This will form the purse section. Pin in place. The finished purse will measure approximately 6" X 6" with flap closed.

Using a blanket stitch, sew up one side, across un-sewn front and down third side to form purse. Refer to pictures.
